





In this module all elements are written for the use of this contest







NOTE: you will have to create your own macros.


For creating macros and use of the  $\langle INT \rangle$  macro, take a look at the MixW4 manual

If you wish to use your own contest macros click on the "..." and select your own contest macro






Select your own Contest macro
